

Overview: The Bamurru Plains experience

The climate in the Northern Territory can be warm and humid. Though in the cooler months, the evenings may be cool. Prepare for the changeable temperature with layered clothing, to be able to remove or add items at any point throughout the day.

While on safari, we recommend wearing lighter fabrics that allow your skin to breathe and protect you from the sun, such as long-sleeved loose cottons and linens. Hats that offer good sun protection, sunglasses as well as high factor SPF sunscreen are essential.

Closed-toe footwear is required to participate in some experiences. Hiking boots are not necessary.

Our wet-edge pool offers a prime spot to cool down, unwind and witness passing wildlife at the end of the day. So please bring your swimming costume. Pool towels are provided.

Dining at Bamurru is an experience and while lunch is a more relaxed occasion, guests are encouraged to dress smart-casual for dinner.

What to Bring

- Long, loose clothing made of cottons, linens and lighter fabrics that allow your skin to breathe and will protect you from the sun
- Casual-smart dress for the evening meal in the main lodge
- Closed-toe footwear is required to participate in some experiences
- Light jumper for the cooler winter months
- Waterproof windcheater
- · Wide-brimmed hat and peaked cap
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Personal first-aid kit including blister protection
- Camera and spare batteries
- · Binoculars optional for wildlife and bird viewing
- Swimming costume to use outdoor pool (pool towels are provided)
- Bamurru provides soap, shampoo, conditioner, robes and towels.

Your guide will carry

- Satellite phone and navigation aid for emergency use
- · Hand-held UHF radio for communication
- · Binoculars for wildlife viewing
- First aid kit
- Species Guides, for flora & fauna identification
